

# QUICK START GUIDE

## Caution

- 1 Verify the local voltage and receptacle type are correct for the scale.
- 2 Place the scale on a level stable surface.
- 3 Avoid sudden temperature changes, vibration, wind and water.
- 4 Avoid load the weight exceed the maximum capacity on the platform
- 5 Please refer to operating instructions specified in manual.
- 6 When clean the scale, please disconnect the power

## Unpacking

Remove the scale from the carton, Inspect the scale for damage, Make sure all components are included

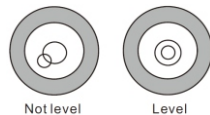
- 1.Label scale    2.Power cord    3.Stainless steel pan    4.Quick start guide

## Leveling

- 1 The scale is equipped with a level indicator located back side of platter
- 2 Use the adjustable leveling feet located on the bottom of the scale until the bubble appears in the center of the indicator.

## Installation

- 1 Place the scale on the level surface.
- 2 Install the stainless steel pan on top of the platter support.



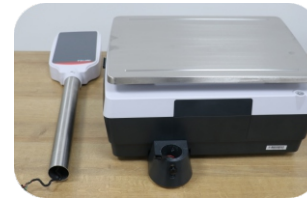
## Power Connection

- 1 Connect the supplied power cable to the power connection socket of the scale.
- 2 Plug the power plug into a correctly grounded power outlet.

- 1 Take out pole display assembly
- 2 Connect male and female connectors well
- 3 Take the cable connectors into the pole
- 4 Insert pole with cable to the holder
- 5 Using the screw to fix the pole to the holder

## Power On/Off

### Power ON

Long press power-on button located below the scale until hearing the " beep " sound and the scale is on.

### Power OFF

**Method 1:** Press off key at the main menu , press "Power Off" at the pop up screen to turn off.

**Method 2:** Long press power-on button to turn off.

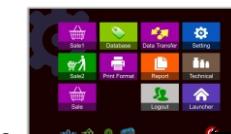
### Restart scale

Press off key at the main menu screen, press "Restart" at the pop up screen to restart the scale

**Note:** Avoid disconnecting the mains power supply directly when switch off the scale, otherwise the weighing data will be lost.



Power on button

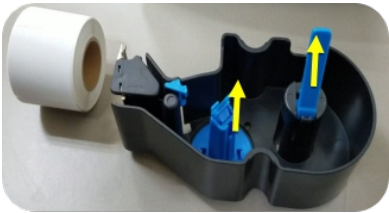

## Label Roll Installation



- 1 Open the printer cover  
Turn lever to open position



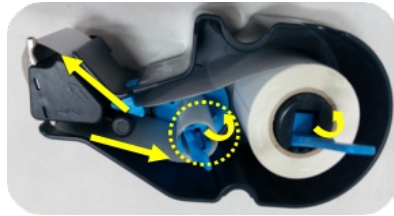
- 3 Release stopper levers

- 2 Remove the cassette



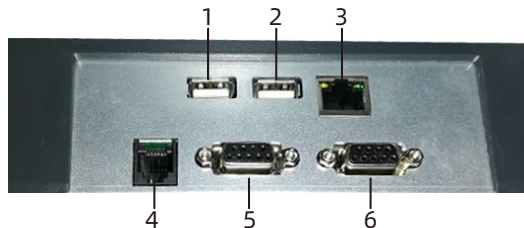
- 4 Insert Back paper under the slot

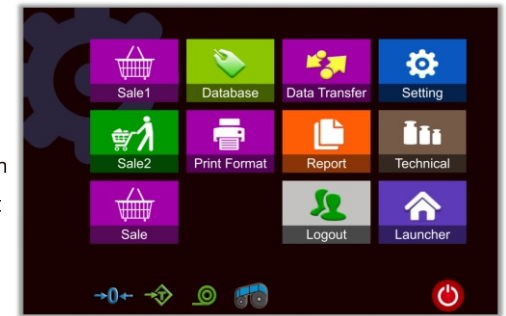
